It Was a Hot One!

The "Thomas Welch" Award, conceived in honor of Howard Blackburn's deceased dorymate, didn't go out this year—no one was seen rowing an inert body 20 miles around Cape Ann...although a few of us felt like that was what we were doing...and the body was ours...

For the second time in the five year history of the Blackburn, heavy heat and flattened seas greeted us in 180° contrast to Howard Blackburn's winter storm row.

There were 162 of us out there, from the states of CT, MA, ME, NC and NH, in 86 craft of all kinds, with ages ranging from 14 to 70 years (that's people—the numbers aren't in yet on the boats). We are also still compiling figures on the following: pounds of sunscreen applied; gallons of water ingested sans swallowing; cubic feet of seawater scooped and dumped over body, and effects on local tides.

To all who accepted the Challenge this year, the Officers and Board of Directors of Cape Ann Rowing Club would like, in the spirit of 1991's Blackburn, to extend a very warm "Thank You!" and our hearty congratulations.

We hope you enjoyed the day as much as we did, and invite you to join us next year, on July 25, 1992, for Blackburn Challenge #6, when the forecast is for a cool, calm, and misty day, with refreshing tailwinds.
